Part 1

Certain Conduct Prohibited

§101. Alcoholic Beverages and Illegal Drugs. No person shall bring onto the premises, possess or consume any alcoholic beverage or illegal drugs of any kind while in attendance at any park, playground and/or recreation area within the Borough; and no person shall enter a park, playground and/or recreation area in an intoxicated state or otherwise be under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs. (Ord. 254, 6/5/1989, §1)

§102. Animals. No person, having possession, custody or control of any animal, shall knowingly or negligently permit any dog or other animal to enter onto the premises of any park, playground and/or recreation area, or to commit any nuisance, i.e., defecation or urination, upon the grounds of any park, playground and/or recreation area within the Borough. (Ord. 254, 6/5/1989, §2)

§103. Prohibitions to be Posted. All parks, playgrounds and/or recreation areas shall be posted as to the prohibition, violation and fine as provided in this Part. (Ord. 254, 6/5/1989, §3)

§104. Penalties. Any person who shall violate any provision of this Part shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine not exceeding six hundred (\$600.00) dollars and costs and, in default of payment thereof, shall be subject to imprisonment for a term not to exceed thirty (30) days. Each day that a violation of this Part continues shall constitute a separate offense. (Ord. 254, 6/5/1989, §4; as amended by Ord. 263, 4/7/1992)

Part 2
Park Hours

§201. Hours. It shall be unlawful for any person to remain in any park, recreational or playground area within the Borough between the hours of 10:00 P.M. and 9:00 A.M. during the months of March through October, and between the hours of 6:00 P.M. and 9:00 A.M. during the months of November through February. (Ord. 215, 9/2/1980, §1; as amended by Ord. 263, 4/7/1992)

§202. Prohibition to be Posted. All restricted areas shall be posted as to prohibition and fine. (Ord. 215, 9/2/1980, §2)

§203. Penalties. Any person who shall violate any provision of this Part shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine not exceeding six hundred (\$600.00) dollars and costs and, in default of payment thereof, shall be subject to imprisonment for a term not to exceed thirty (30) days. Each day that a violation of this Part continues shall constitute a separate offense. (Ord. 215, 9/2/1980, §3; as amended by Ord. 263, 4/7/1992)

Part 3
Vehicle Pathways

§301. Vehicle Pathways. It shall be unlawful for any person to ride a wheeled vehicle except on vehicle pathways in any park, recreational or playground area in the Borough. (Ord. 198, 12/28/1976, §1)

§302. Posting of Restricted Areas. All restricted areas shall be posted as to prohibition, violation and fine. (Ord. 198, 12/28/1976, §2)

§303. Penalties. Any person who shall violate any provision of this Part shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine not exceeding six hundred (\$600.00) dollars and costs and, in default of payment thereof, shall be subject to imprisonment for a term not to exceed thirty (30) days. Each day that a violation of this Part continues shall constitute a separate offense. (Ord. 198, 12/28/1976, §3; as amended by Ord. 214, 9/2/1980, §1; and by Ord. 263, 4/7/1992)

Part 4

Defacing of Public Grounds

§401. Unlawful to Deface or Pollute Public Grounds. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to cut, break, mar, deface, or injure any tree, shrub, flowering plant, ornamental plant, building, structure, equipment, fence, real or personal property in or upon the public grounds maintained by the Borough. Public grounds include parks, playgrounds, trails, paths, recreational areas, public areas, sites for schools, sewage treatment, refuse disposal, public owned or operated facilities, public owned or operated scenic and historic sites. (Ord. 42, 6/3/1926, §1; as amended by Ord. 263, 4/7/1992)

§402. Penalties. Any person who shall violate any provision of this Part shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine not exceeding six hundred (\$600.00) dollars and costs and, in default of payment thereof, shall be subject to imprisonment for a term not to exceed thirty (30) days. Each day that a violation of this Part continues shall constitute a separate offense. (Ord. 42, 6/3/1926, §2; as amended by Ord. 263, 4/7/1992)
